

RECREATING THE LOST "BLUE CAR"

CHAPTER 18



We are pleased to bring the next chapter of a series on Greg Raymond's restoration project to build a Tribute to the Royal Bobcat Blue Car from the March 1964 Car and Driver road test. This month's chapter highlights the restoration of the original OEM, 62 year old interior dash bezel. I am amazed at the level of detail and the quality of workmanship Greg has undertaken to accurately replicate the Pilot Car that participated in the infamous C&D Road Test that jump-started GTO sales and the Muscle Car era!

Working with a perfectionist is amazing, time consuming... but amazing none the less. The team at Patterson's Customs decided that the dash bezel needed to be recreated in exacting detail. This required a series of steps that go so far beyond what I have ever seen. I felt it was worthy of documentation.



Here we have the original dash bezel as it appeared after 62 years of service. It suffered from all the usual degradation. The chrome finish had all but disappeared, the Tahoe Blue, or "Dash Insert Blue" anti-reflection detail survived, but was inconsistent in appearance, and of course the Dark Aqua "Code 217" required a refinish to what the "Blue Car's" original Black "Code 214" was created with.



I am quite pleased to have been archiving every process in this long and extensive restoration/recreation. This photo unveils a GM manufacturing detail. You have to see it to believe it. Using good old fashioned Easy-Off oven cleaner we took everything left still adhered to this OEM part right down to the injection molded blank. This level of autopsy revealed the multi-color signature created by using the plastic resin pellets made up of multiple colors.

We started with a fresh coat of the correct low-gloss / dead-flat black (essentially 0% gloss). This finish is not satin, not semi-gloss, and not interior vinyl paint. It's closer to a "camera-flat" black. To replicate it we used a product by SEM, Trim Black 39143.



Now for the most interesting part of this process. If you have ever restored a car, you have likely looked into the costly spray chrome systems and the vacuum metalizing processes. We have all failed with the low buck chrome spray paints that never live up to their label claims... until now! Revell has come up with a spray chrome paint that is outstanding! Sure, at over thirty bucks for a 5oz can its pricey, but the results are stunning!

After the chrome areas of the dash bezel were complete, we were ready to install the freshened up factory gauges and add the finishing touch, the dash bezel insert. The 1964 GTO featured a signature swirled aluminum dash insert setting it apart from the Tempest and LeMans. This engine-turned aluminum dash insert was stamped from a thin sheet of .03" aluminum and given a swirl pattern using engine turning.



The reproduction part available for this detail is more of a decal than an aluminum insert. This decal is nearly impossible to apply but also is not an exact fit to a 62 year old heavily heat cycled plastic dash bezel.

But of course the Patterson's went the extra mile. Using a sheet of .03" stainless and the reproduction decal an absolute perfect reproduction of what Pontiac created in 1964 was replicated. The end result is simply breathtaking!

Next month we finish up the front end... The Suspen(ce)sion is killing me!
