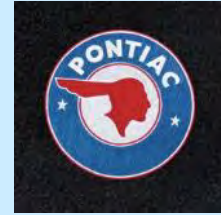

NOTES FROM THE NEWSLETTER EDITOR

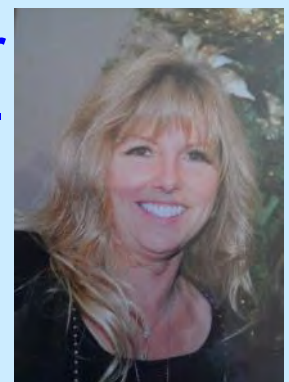
