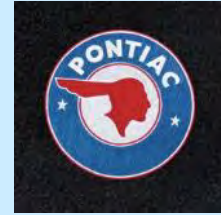

NOTES FROM THE CHIEF



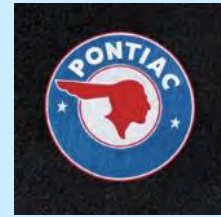
August 30, 2023 – President's Notes

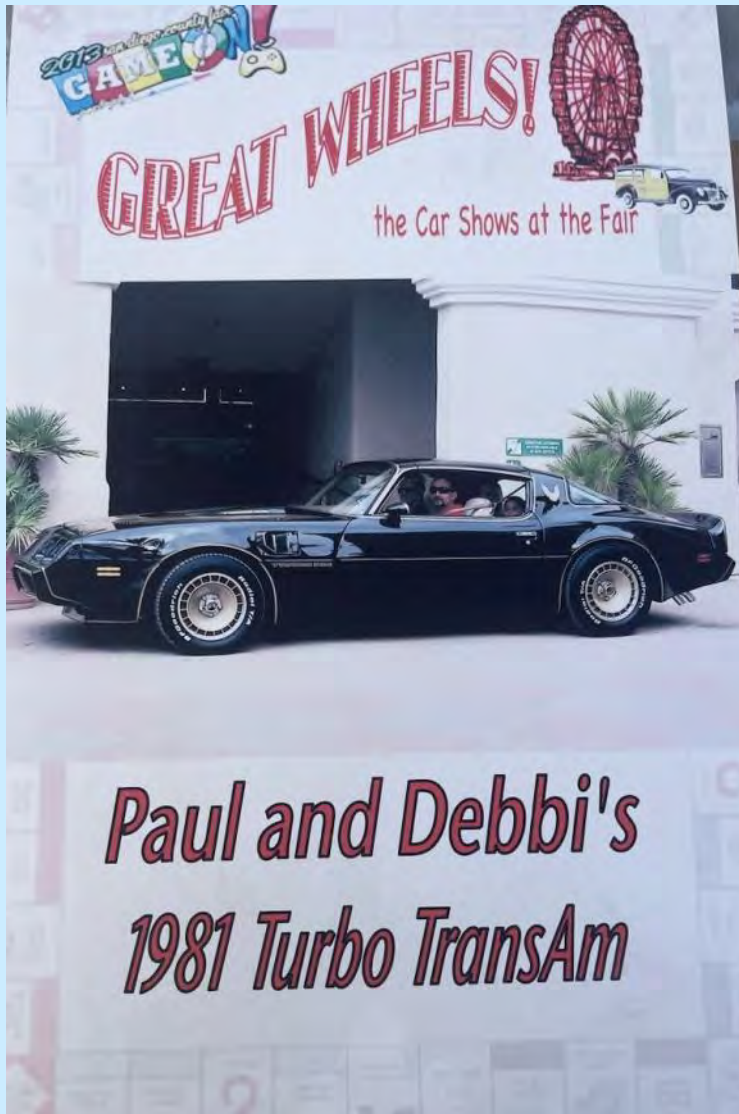
PAUL AGUILAR: A FRIEND TO ALL
