





RECREATING THE LOST 'BLUE CAR'

CHAPTER 12



We are pleased to bring the next chapter of a series on Greg Raymond's restoration project to build a Tribute to the Royal Bobcat Blue Car from the March 1964 Car and Driver road test. As the body and paint process finishes up, this months article focuses on Ace Wilson's Royal Pontiac dealership where both the Red and Blue test cars were "prepped" for the Car and Driver test.

While we wait patiently for our Nocturne Blue paint to dry I thought it would be nice to spotlight Royal Pontiac. The Royal Pontiac dealership was started by Asa "Ace" Wilson in the late 1950s. The dealership quickly became known for its super-tuned Pontiac's which became a common sight in Detroit. Pontiac Motor Division struck an informal "partnership" with the dealership. Royal Pontiac was responsible for the modifying and tuning the two 1964 GTO's transforming them into what became known as Royal Bobcats for the Car and Driver feature.

The original Royal Bobcats were based on the Pontiac Catalina. The dealership's prepped vehicles with a unique paint scheme and the iconic Royal Bobcat badging.

In 1964 the Royal Bobcat treatment was applied to the new Pontiac GTO and one could order any of the 38 different upgrades and options, including performance kits that could be purchased over the counter or by mail order.



Sadly, the dealership closed in 1971 due to a shrinking market for performance cars. Milt Schornack and George DeLorean attempted to continue creating super-powered Pontiac's under the name Royal Automotive, but the partnership dissolved.

I was able to travel to the original site of the Royal Pontiac dealership in 2005 with Jim Wangers while working for Jim and filming for Jim's "Crusin' Woodward" DVD production. at that time it was Jim Fresard Pontiac & Buick which is also now closed.






Wake Up to Cars & Coffee at San Diego Automotive Museum Every 3rd Sunday of Month
