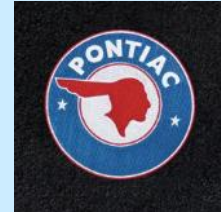

Last weekend, January 10–12, my wife Carly and I headed out to Palm Springs for the annual Paradise Roadshow at the Ace Hotel. 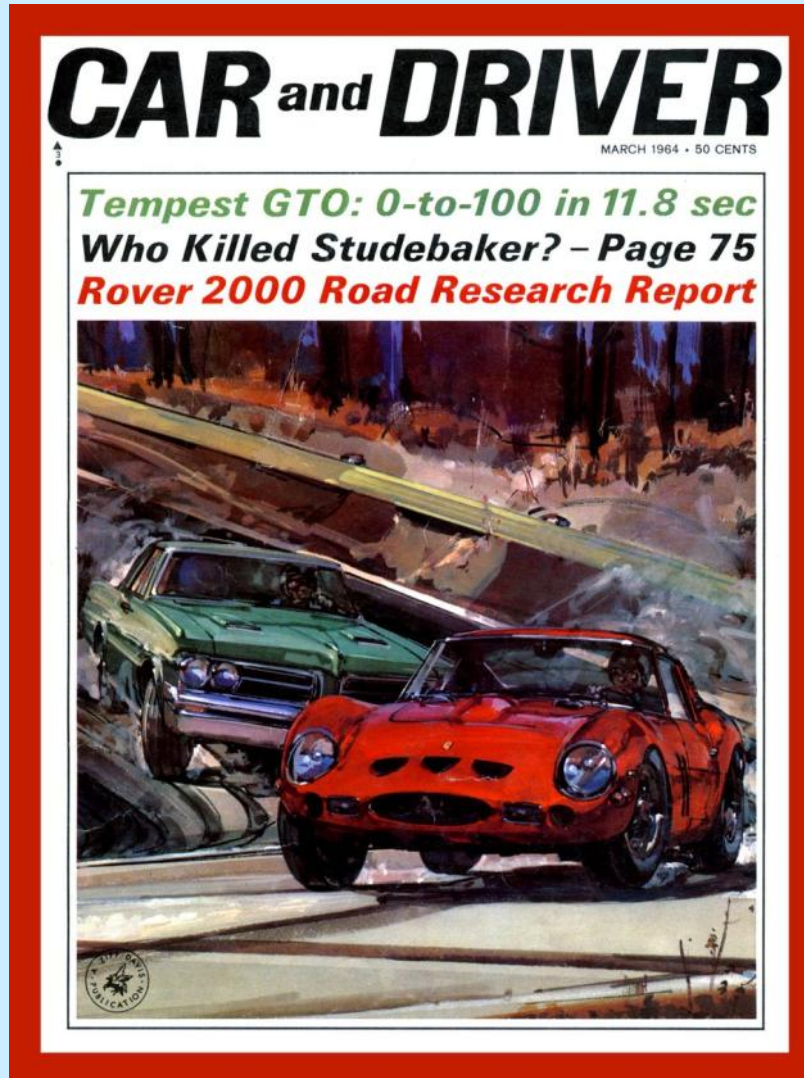

RECREATING THE LOST "BLUE CAR"

CHAPTER 17



We are pleased to bring the next chapter of a series on Greg Raymond's restoration project to build a Tribute to the Royal Bobcat Blue Car from the March 1964 Car and Driver road test. This month's chapter highlights the restoration of the rear trim panels followed by the front grills. Just amazing the detail and quality of workmanship Greg has undertaken to accurately replicate the Pilot Car that participated in the infamous C&D Road Test that jump-started GTO sales and the Muscle Car era!

REVIVING GLORY: TRIM “BLUE CAR” - CHAPTER 17

“A Tribute to Jim Wangers’ 1964 GTO ‘Test Car’ built for Car and Driver’s March 1964 Road Test”

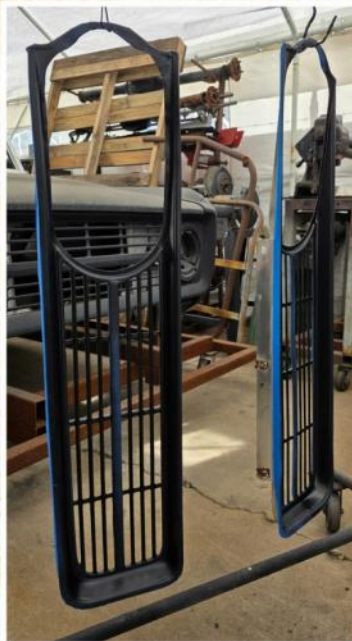
With the “Blue Car” out of the paint booth and in assembly it was time to start focusing on the trim. After over 60 years, the typical desegregation of all the trim components was abundant. Repainting Pontiac taillight panels and the fuel filler door trim is something that I am quite familiar with having done it on several of my previous builds. Starting with a thorough cleaning in the parts washer I was able to get to the bare chrome plated pot metal. Using a 10ML/CC Ink Filling Syringe with a Blunt Needle Tip and some Testors enamel paint is one of those wonderfully meditative restoration tasks where patience pays off in a big way. The trick is treating the trim like miniature model-car detailing: clean the grooves thoroughly, lay down a smooth base coat, and then load just the tiniest bead of enamel onto the needle’s tip.

Instead of brushing, you flow the paint into the recessed lines, letting surface tension do the work. It gives you razor sharp edges, factory correct contrast, and a level of control you’d never get with a traditional brush. It’s slow, steady work but when the blacked out lines and Marimba Red snap against fresh chrome the result looks like it rolled straight out of Pontiac’s design studio.



The front grills required a different technique. The primary issue with the grills is that they were stamped aluminum that were anodized. While cleaning them was the same process, we needed to be very careful as to not polish off the anodized surface. Once clean and dry the tedious use of blue painters tape to mask off the areas that needed to stay polished was necessary. Finally, using black trim paint from SEM we were able to get that factory finish that really made them pop. Next month we dive into the front suspension, steering and power brake upgrade that only the blue car had for the Car and Driver test session.

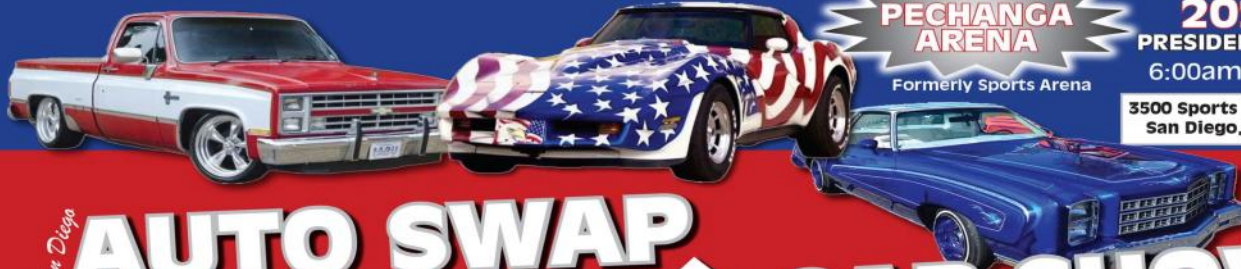

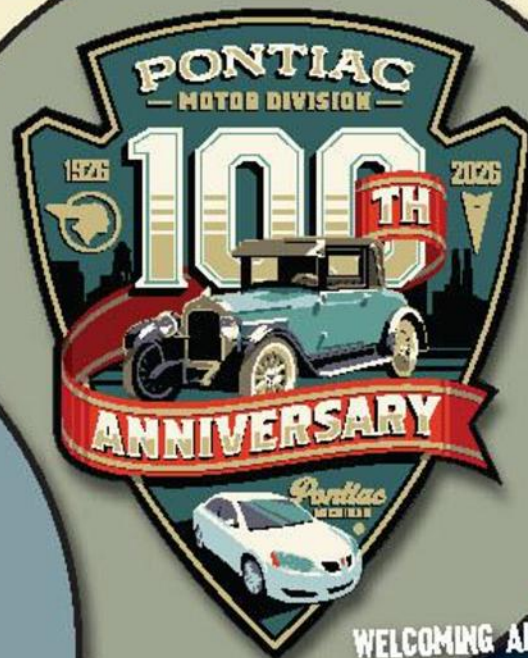

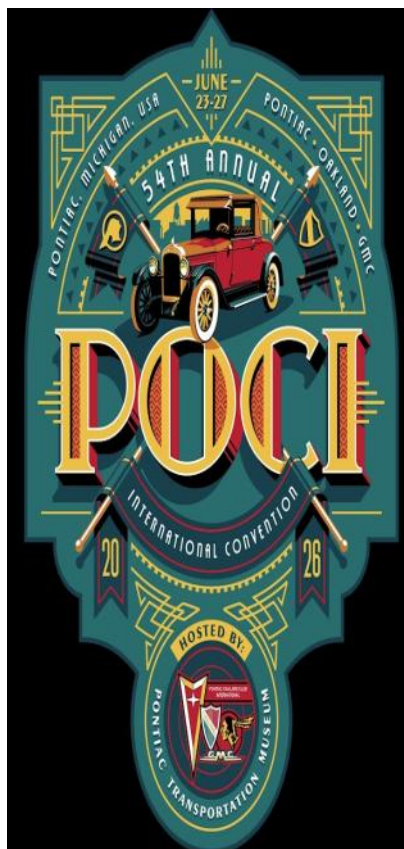
