



- Shane Roberts joined the meeting with his wife and son. He owns a 1989 light metallic blue Firebird Formula.
- Mark and Jennifer Hass. Mark purchased his 1973 Grand Am from Eddy Roche Pontiac in Wheaton, Illinois. It was nearly complete on the frame off restoration in 1989. When he came back from a Navy cruise, it was gone. He found it 17 years later at the Ace Towing Yard in East County. He's in the finishing stages of restoring it for the third time.

He competed in the Thunder Down Under car race that takes place on the salt flats of Lake Gairdner in South Australia. He will be remembered for his great smile, his mechanical ingenuity, and the Christmas parties he and Lori hosted for the club. He also loved to make chili and it was always his gift to members at the Swap Meet.

Les passed away February 10. His memorial service will be held later this month.

Treasurer's Report:

Sue reported that the club has 29 active members. She also submitted a typed report stating that income derived from memberships was \$475 for 2025. The club subsidized \$260 for members at the Installation of Officers breakfast at the Tequila Factory in Old Town San Diego. The administrative fee of \$35 was paid to the San Diego Port District for our 2025 Cops & Rodders Fall Pow Wow car show.

At this time, it was noted that the Minutes of November 12 were not approved at the December 17 meeting.

MOTION:

A motion was made and seconded to approve the Minutes of November 12 and December 17, 2024. The motion passed unanimously.

February 22, 2025 – Activities Director Roland Short shared plans for the upcoming cruise to Rainbow Oaks Restaurant. Members in the southern part of San Diego County will meet at JBA at 9:30 a.m., then travel to a meeting point north to join with North County participants.

New Business:

Bill reported that the San Diego Association of Car Clubs is calling their gatherings "Meet-Ups" in lieu of "Meetings". Its next meet-up on April 1 will be held at the Classic Malt Shop in Point Loma, where there will be music, drawings, prizes and a 50/50 raffle. The Council also awards \$500 to the charity of one lucky chosen club. Meet-ups will be held every other month on the first Tuesday of April, June, August and October.

Bill informed club members that a new law, AB 2807, was signed into law on January 1, 2025. He said the bill states that any person may be prosecuted if they are a spectator of a race on streets and even on private property.

AB 2807, Section 1. 23109. (a) A person shall not engage in a motor vehicle speed contest on a highway or in an off street parking facility... (b) A person shall not aid or abet in a motor vehicle speed contest on a highway or in an off street parking facility.

Bill suggested that everyone read the Assembly Bill for clarification.

Old Business

Bill asked if Sue had reached the Fisher House representative and was told "yes". Sue said donations to Fleet Week and to the San Diego Police Museum were complete.

It was noted that the January Installation of Officers was a success.






This is a 1932 Packard, twin-six, 905 series. It weighed 6600 lb, 25 gal. gas tank with 2 fillers, 10 qt. oil pan,3 speed trans. I had this car from 1948 to 1952, when I was in high school. I rebuilt the engine in 1949. I gave the car to Jack Lutts to keep for me when I went to Korea 1953 to 1954. He could not drive it the way it was, bad brakes, etc. So he put it in a junk yard in Ocean Park. About 12 years later, at a car auction (Cars for the Stars) I talked to the guy that bought the engine out of it, and he wanted to know if I wanted to buy it back. (I declined, had nothing that could fit it!) I think the picture was taken about 1947. The location was west LA, one block north of Culver Blvd and one block west of Centinela Ave.










VALLEY OF THE SUN PONTIAC SHOW 2025






Wake Up to Cars & Coffee at San Diego Automotive Museum Every 3rd Sunday of Month
